4.1 Gawler - 11 May

- Won't be having info sessions this year
- Looking for a draw card – Maggie Beer not available. Lynette suggested Milton Voudoulis and will find out how much he charged when he spoke at Two Wells Library

4.2 Light - 30 August – Lorinda and Deb will check out Light Community Church in Kapunda as a possible venue.

4.3 Barossa

- Deb has booked 25 & 26 October as there is uncertainty about how much space will be available as the Coop will be leasing kiosks in the middle of the Mall so holding the Expo over 2 days was one option.
- Lorinda suggested a large marquee at the south end of the Mall.
- Elspeth provided the following feedback via email:

Pro of back to back days:

- Every one gets a chance, it's done and dusted in one hit (more work 2X sessions @ different times of year)

Cons of back to back days:

- Clients/'consumers are not going to grasp that if they are there one day that to see everything that the Barossa delivers that they need to come back on a second day. Could leave people thinking we have far less services locally than what we really have....re those that don't come back second day.

Another suggestion although hard to deliver to service providers.....

- We limit our stall holders to actual providers that deliver services in our local Barossa region. The groups that attend that are more advocacy/information could have pamphlets distributed somewhere. Some of the service providers there last year do not have much to do with Barossa. This is why CADL have never had a stall at Two Wells/Mallala as realistically our services do not extend to those regions.
- Did service providers have 1X table to themselves? Maybe they should reduce their banners/promo materials and have two to a table?
- Maybe we explore our lay-out options?

We will decide when we visit the Mall later in the meeting.

7.1 2018 Excellence in Public Health Awards

Lorinda presented a draft nomination of the *Ageing in Style Regional Roadshow* for the 2018 Minister's Excellence in Public Health Awards, in the Regional Council category. 6. VISIT BAROSSA COOP MALL

The Working Group walked over to the Barossa Coop Mall - and decided the following:

- We'd like to book the northern end of the Mall and also maybe utilise the undercover space out front of the PO and Stationery shop. If it was cold and/or windy we could use gazebos with a roof and one side providing protection against the weather
- We'd like to review the situation closer to the date ie early September, to see how much space will be available.
- By then we will know how many kiosks are occupied and if the shop front next to the Flight Centre is occupied.
- In the first instance we will restrict stall holders to local providers – and state wide service providers eg ARAS

- Stall holders will bring their own trestles on the day.
- Deb will cancel booking for the 26 October and keep Thursday 25 October
- Courtney and Deb will do a floor plan and work out how many stalls we can fit in the space
