#### 4. PO REPORT

Tabled. Key points:

- Stocktake Report submitted to DoH covering July to December 2017
- 2018 Barossa Ageing in Style Expo's: Gawler – 11 May; Kapunda 30 August (TBC); Barossa 25 & 26 October.
- The Collaborative Projects are organising an event for 6 July to build on the capacity of service providers to deliver wellness and re-ablement. Deb is advocating for to be held in a venue closer to the north and will apply for funding from SA Country PHN to cover costs of

producing, directing and filming role plays which will be an integral part of the event to provide practical visual examples of how to 'do' wellness and re-ablement from RAS assessment to service delivery.

- Putting together a program of T&D following survey of independent contractors undertaken in late 2017. BPP can provide some and will approach RDA for small business training. Information about T&D can be included in newsletters and information sessions for IC's. Simon suggested Mental Health First Aid training – short course – will send Deb details of a course held at BV recently.
- Pop-Up Expos with Gawler & Districts Community Services Forum members at Gawler Green and Gawler Central Shopping Centres.

## **5. FINANCIAL REPORT**

Elsbeth was successful in applying for \$1,000 from Community Helpers for the Ageing in Style Expos. Will possible use some this financial year for Gawler Expo and carry over balance to 2018/19

## **6. DISCUSSION**

- Suggested that stall holders at Pop Up Expos promote other services as well as their own. Unlikely in the current competitive environment, however a directory of services by service type might be useful for consumers. Sanna will send Deb an example.
- CHSP service providers are reviewing level of service received by grandfathered clients. Most are being over serviced.
- The Northern Collab Project is running a "Better Questions Workshop" to assist service providers to ask difficult questions of their clients about their support needs. Cost is \$130 each. Deb will send flyer.
- How do you 'do' wellness and re-ablement when CHSP client just wants a single service eg gutter clean? Also, how do you measure it?
- BV is currently involved with Quality of Life Indicators project. HCP goal setting focus on 'better living' not service delivery. Also will be surveying Retirement Living residents in an attempt to measure wellness.
- Simon observed that the Library is increasingly becoming a known meeting place for older people.

## **8. OTHER BUSINESS**

SCAP Activity Work Plan 2018 -2012

- Current contract and Activity Work Plan ends 30 June.
- What are priorities for 2018-2020?
- Difficult to know at this stage until new contracts for CHSP are in place.
- Likely to be a focus on wellness and re-ablement.
- Keep doing the same – meetings of service providers and RAS are very helpful.
