ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Council may, on application, consider granting a rebate of that portion of general rates where the increase in the amount payable **is greater than 7.5%** from the 2017/2018 rating year in respect of an assessment, provided that the following criteria are satisfied:

- a is the property for which you are making application for rebate your principal place of residence? YES / NO
- b has the property been your principal place of residence since at least 1st July 2017 (ratepayers moving into the property after that date do not qualify for the current year) YES / NO

If you have answered 'NO' to a or b above, the rebate is not available

- c have any improvements been made over \$20,000 which would affect the capital value of the property? YES / NO
- d is any commercial/industrial/primary production activity being carried out at the property? YES / NO

If you have answered 'YES' to c or d above, the rebate is not available
