



**Barossa Bushgardens** regional native flora centre is a unique community project which promotes the local native plants of the Barossa region.

Plantings commenced in 2001 and still continue with the assistance of a vast number of local volunteers and growers.

Plantings have evolved from the original seed orchard row configurations to the six current feature gardens such as the CFS Fire-wise garden. These water-wise display gardens demonstrate how natives can be grown in our own backyards.

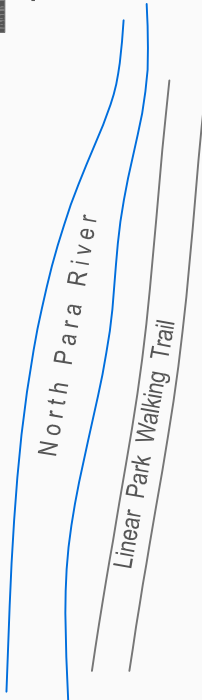

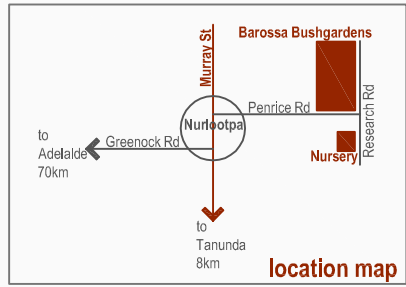
