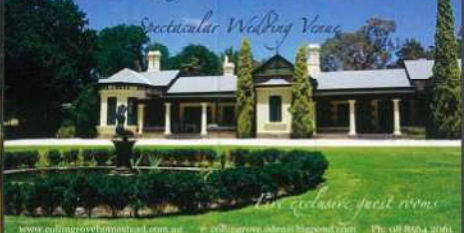

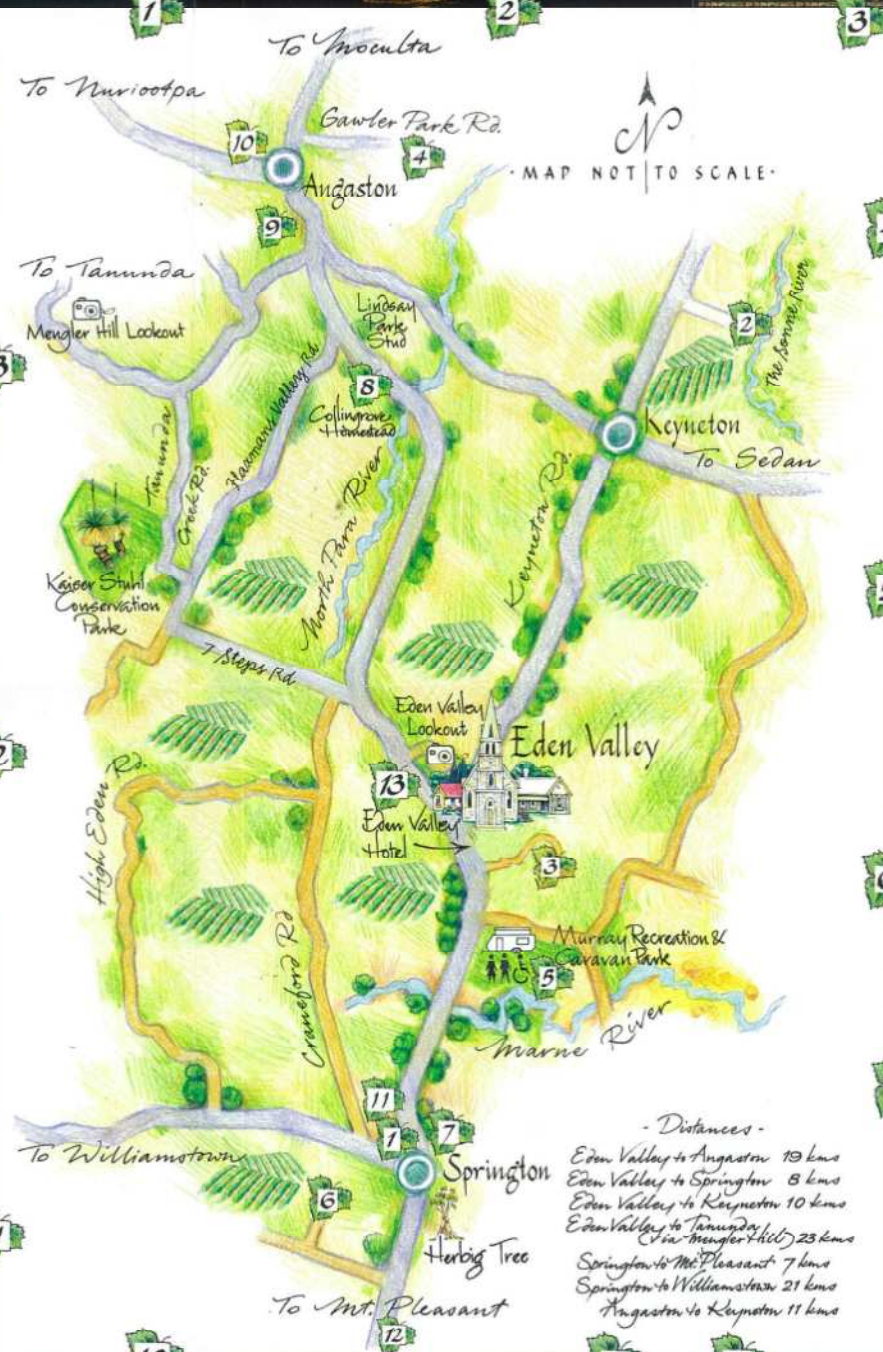

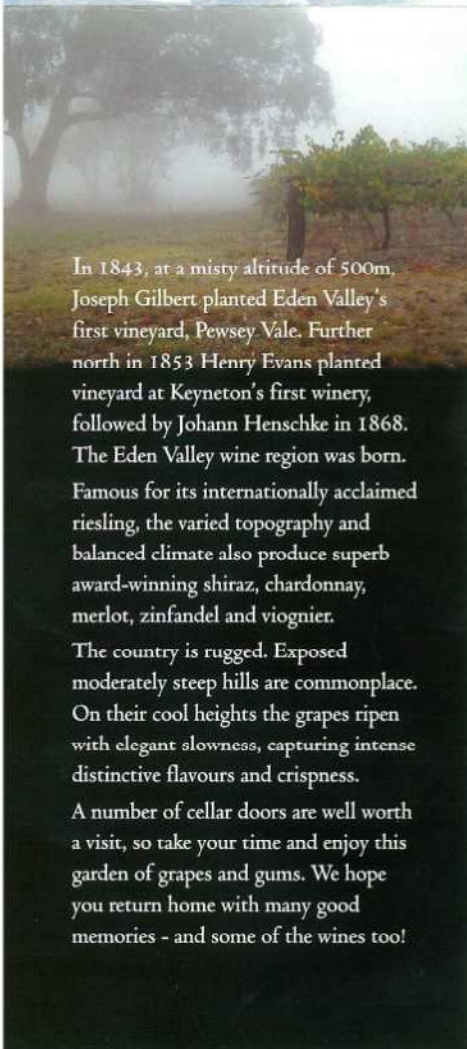

## Prime beef AND LAMB



The nearby Murray Recreation and Caravan Park has BBQ facilities, and can be a great base from which to explore some of the many walking trails around. Meander slowly through this valley of Eden and experience for yourself the history, hospitality, scenery, food and of course the wines.



In 1843, at a misty altitude of 500m, Joseph Gilbert planted Eden Valley's first vineyard, Pewsey Vale. Further north in 1853 Henry Evans planted vineyard at Keyneton's first winery, followed by Johann Henschke in 1868. The Eden Valley wine region was born. Famous for its internationally acclaimed riesling, the varied topography and balanced climate also produce superb award-winning shiraz, chardonnay, merlot, zinfandel and viognier.

The country is rugged. Exposed moderately steep hills are commonplace. On their cool heights the grapes ripen with elegant slowness, capturing intense distinctive flavours and crispness.

A number of cellar doors are well worth a visit, so take your time and enjoy this garden of grapes and gums. We hope you return home with many good memories - and some of the wines too!

## SALTED WITH

The park is open from sunrise to sunset every day. Possum may be seen foraging for food at dusk. afternoon, while the occasional echidna or open grasslands in the early morning or late observe the park's wildlife. Kangaroos feed on Dusk and early mornings are the best time to across the ranges to the Barossa Valley. The park's main features, include rock formations and a scenic lookout, while the Stringybark Loop provides insight to the park's diverse flora and fauna.

Nested amongst the Barossa Ranges, the Kaiser Stuhl Conservation Park is perfect for bushwalkers. Walking trails pass through a variety of landscapes including creeks, rocky outcrops, areas of low forest, scrub and open grassland. The park has panoramic views across the ranges to the Barossa Valley. The park's main features, include rock formations and a scenic lookout, while the Stringybark Loop provides insight to the park's diverse flora and fauna.

When the word 'Eden' was carved into a redgum over 150 years ago, its author could hardly foresee that this word would come to define a world class wine producing region. The 'Eden' tree is gone, but thousands of redgums still characterise this unique valley of Eden'. Described by locals as 'God's own country', the valley produces prime beef, dairy, sheep and horses, as well as grapes. The earliest residents, the Peramangk and Ngadjuri tribes, made shelters in the red-gums, and used the bark for making canoes. Later, mail and deliveries found dry spots in carved-out hollows of old redgums, too. English and German immigrants settled Eden Valley in the 1850s and by the early 1900s there were two general stores, a flourmill, a bootmaker, butcher, two blacksmiths and a farmer. Remains of the butter factory can be seen near the General Store.
