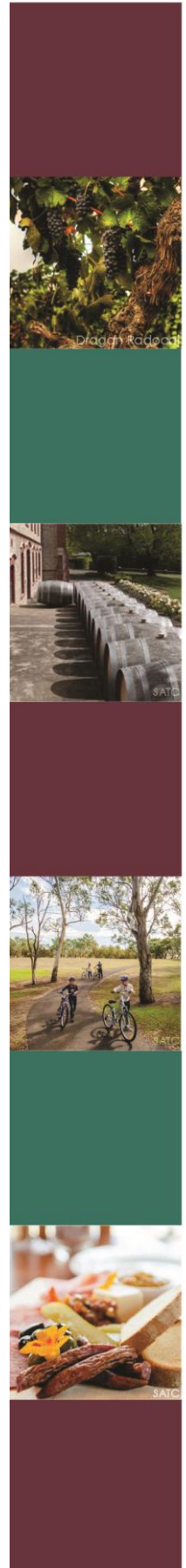

## Cleaning Requirements
