BUSINESS ARISING

A recent Council workshop on restructuring of S41 community committees resulted in proposals being presented to Council members for consideration of the preferred option.

The apparent increase in water rates to be kept in mind for review in the next year's expense budget.

The condition of Show Hall floor will require closer inspection by Council to ensure it is acceptable for use for playing table tennis.

FINANCE

Financial statements presented for May 2014.

GENERAL BUSINESS

N Vaughan reported that roof gutters on all buildings would be due for cleaning now that most of the leaves have fallen.

D Zimmermann reported that the earthen stormwater drain on the eastern side of the tennis courts has silted up and runoff is draining onto the lower level courts.

Cricket club representative, Graham Strathearn, presented a proposal to replace the existing concrete wicket on the oval with turf wickets. The main concern is the potential effect of the clay surface on water logging during winter as experienced at Tanunda. Graham assured that professionally installed wickets with proper provision of drainage, such as Glenelg, causes minimal problems. The wicket will require low salinity water for irrigation. A test of the bore water is required to determine if it is suitable, otherwise mains water will be required.

MOVED: N Vaughan, that this proposal be accepted in principle subject to submission of final installation details. The cricket club would be responsible for maintaining the wickets.

Seconded: P Feist CARRIED

Graham also reported that the netball club have completed cleaning of the tennis courts at a cost of \$4000, as well as repairs and patching of the surface of half for \$2500, with the balance to follow.
