GENERAL BUSINESS

The hot water system in the ladies change rooms in the Centenary Building has failed and been replaced.

S Barnden reported that the concrete steps at the outside entrance to the Show Hall Office were hazardous, and requested addition of a ramp with landing. Also the Show Society are considering extra Show hall space for future shows with a marquee and have requested an entrance door on the northern wall for access to it. This would also provide an alternative emergency exit from the Show Hall. M Grossman to look into available grants to assist with funding.

M Grossman reported one of the point posts at the southern end of the oval was broken.

N Vaughan advised a quote from Jim's tree removals for \$8,000 to remove the sugar gums on the southern side of the Show Hall. Council have advised that a public consultation would be desirable prior to undertaking this work. The actual work would be dependent on funding being available.
