GENERAL BUSINESS

Request from Barossa Table Tennis Assoc. for hire of Show Hall for regular tournaments usually held fortnightly running from April to August. Anticipate 6 tables would be set up. Likely to require improved lighting – to try replacing tubes but may need to consider extra supply.

Committee agreed in principle with tables remaining set up subject to being cleared for other functions should they arise. Hire fee to be determined.

Report on park activities:

- Council has been undertaking numerous repairs to toilet blocks
- Dwayne has reported and cleaned graffiti from skate rink
- Dwayne reported untidiness around Football Clubrooms – old insulation, redundant concrete tank, general rubbish
- Park users have complained of dog droppings found on oval – no information regarding dog owner/s
- All areas of park now being mowed by contractor – to keep watch on oval.

P Feist reported food packaging refuse being left on the ground near rubbish bins due to not fitting through the restricted opening. Suggestion made to unlock bins for home games, or try to source alternative packaging.
