BUSINESS ARISING

Some progress on renovations of the Show Hall so far include installation of a personal exit door in the western wall and replacement of some flooring boards.

As upgrading the electricity cable to the centre of the oval would involve complete replacement with new conduit and trenching, and its main use is for show purposes, it was agreed that the logical thing was to terminate it at the perimeter of the oval, trying to utilise the existing conduit under the road. Cr M Grossman reported that the show would be happy to run a lead from the perimeter to the centre or use a generator.

G Strathearn reported a budget for new initiatives has been submitted to Council.

GENERAL BUSINESS

D Zimmermann reported immense dust intrusion into his property on the weekend of the show from horse activities adjacent to their boundary fence, which was extremely annoying and resulted in pollution nuisance to his property. Discussion on dust being a general problem at this time of the year is virtually impossible to avoid. However, considerably more could have been done by thoroughly irrigating the area utilised. He offered to assist in coordinating this for future shows.

G Strathearn reported that the cricket club are looking at installing bore irrigation to the grassed area around the practice nets.

Minutes of the Angas Recreation Park Committee meeting 25 March 2015

Cr M Grossman reported a water pipe at the western gate being pierced by a marquee peg during the show. It was buried just under the surface. Some concern from Council in relation to straw left over by the show.

N Vaughan presented a proposal to install more deep drainage pipes into oval – agreed to add to new initiatives.

Cr J Angas suggested that a job should be raised to clean up the grass clippings being deposited around the terraces by the oval mowing contractor.
