

Santos TOUR DOWN UNDER – NOVATECH STAGE TWO

The NOVATECH Stage 2 of the 2019 SANTOS Tour Down Under is being held on Wednesday 16 January 2019 and will finish in Angaston after the start in Norwood. The following Road Closures and Parking Restrictions will be put in place:

Middle Street, Angaston from Murray Street to Cross Street between 12.00am on Tuesday 15 January 2019 and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Murray Street, Angaston from Sturt Street to North Street between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Schilling Street, Angaston from Murray Street to Hill Street East between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Hannay Crescent, Angaston in its entirety between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

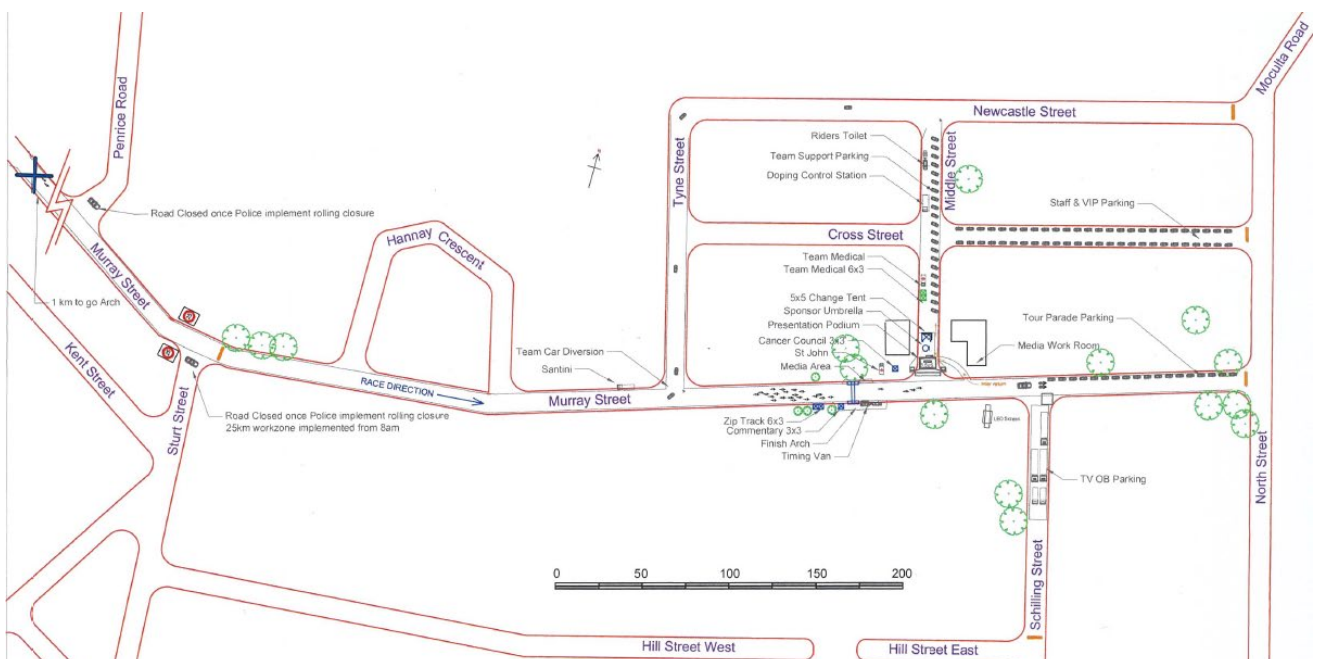
Tyne Street, Angaston from Murray Street to Newcastle Street between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Newcastle Street, Angaston in its entirety between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Middle Street, Angaston from Cross Street to Newcastle Street between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Cross Street, Angaston in its entirety between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.

Shemmeld Lane, Angaston in its entirety between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019.



And Speed and Parking Restrictions including:-

No parking and 25km/h speed restriction to apply between 6.00am and 7.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019 on both sides of:

Murray Street / Angaston Road, Angaston between 489 Angaston Road and Sturt Street

No parking to apply between 11.00am and 1.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019 on:

Williamstown Road, Springton between Mildres Street and Miller Street on both sides of the road

No parking to apply between 11.00am and 1.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019 on:

Miller Street, Springton between Williamstown Road / Hamiltons Road and Angas Street / Daly Street on the west side of the road

No parking to apply between 11.00am and 3.00pm on Wednesday 16 January 2019 on:

Eden Valley Road, Eden Valley between Rushlea Road and Matthews Road / Keyneton Road on both sides of the road

You may contact Council if you foresee any significant concerns with limited access on Wednesday 16 January. TDU traffic marshals will be monitoring the road closures on the day and will do what they can to assist with resident access however please note that vehicle access between the critical timeframes of 11am – 4pm will not be provided. There will be no vehicle access on Murray Street during the road closure. To avoid frustration an alternative travel plan for the day may be beneficial, in particular, please consider parking your vehicle outside of the road closure zone.

Waste Pick-ups

Due to the road closures and the significant television exposure that the Santos Tour Down Under generates, please be advised that your waste / recycling pick up will now be prior to 6am on Wednesday 16 January 2019. Please ensure your bins are placed for collection on Tuesday evening 15 January 2019 and placed away on morning of Wednesday 16 January 2019. This will assist in making sure that our region presents beautifully on the world stage.
