YOUR GREEN ORGANIC BIN SERVICE

To reduce the amount of waste going to landfill, green organic bin services are mandatory for residential properties within the township boundaries of Angaston, Cockatoo Valley, Eden Valley, Lyndoch, Mount Pleasant, Moculta, Nuriootpa, Penrice, Sandy Creek, Springton, Stockwell, Tanunda, and Williamstown. Commercial premises within the designated waste collection area can opt in for a green organics bin.
