NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Garreth Lee Jones, Acting Senior Sergeant of Police, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that the '**Fleurieu to Flinders Rally 2026 – Stage 35 and 37**' is an event to which this section applies and that the following roads be closed to traffic **between 11.00am and 5.30pm on Thursday 24 September 2026**:

Within The Barossa Council: -

Stage 35 – Mount Karinya

- **Pipeline Road, Moculta** from 750 metres from Keyneton Road for 1.7 kilometres

Stage 37 – Trial Hill Road

- **Tweedies Gull Road, Williamstown** from 407 Tweedies Gully Road to Trial Hill Road
- **Trial Hill Road, Altona** from Tweedies Gully Road to Corryton Park Road
- **Corryton Park Road, Pewsey Vale** Road between Trial Hill Road and High Eden Road
- **High Eden Road, Flaxman Valley** between Corryton Road and Frenchs Road.

I direct that persons taking part in the '**Fleurieu to Flinders Rally 2026 – Stage 35 and 37**' on the above roads be exempted, in relation to a road on which the event is to be held, from the duty to observe any enactment, regulation or by-law prescribing a rule to be observed on roads by drivers of vehicles.

I further direct that the event must comply with the following:

- Comply with all Motorsport Australia requirements
- All closures must be conducted by personnel with the appropriate Work Zone Traffic Management training and utilising approved signage.
- All vehicles participating must be registered and road worthy
- All participants must hold appropriate drivers licence and not be disqualified from driving or from holding a licence in any State or Territory.
- Participants are not exempt from RTA offences related to drink and drug driving.

I also hereby authorise the **Fleurieu to Flinders Rally** or its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event.

I direct that the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event can only be performed by a person with work zone traffic management training.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the **"SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management"** (which calls up the **Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
