NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Christopher Drew Holland, Senior Sergeant First Class of Police, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that the '**2026 MSS Safety Rally Barossa**' is an event to which this section applies and that the following roads be closed to all traffic **between the listed times and dates below:**

Within The Barossa Council area: -

SS1 & SS8 HIGH TRIAL 1 & 2

- **Trial Hill Road** between a point appx. 2km east of Tweedies Gully Road and Wirra Wirra Road
 - **Corryton Park Road** between Wirra Wirra Road and Brownes Road (*Mawson Trail*)
 - **Brownes Road** between Corryton Park Road and Heggies Range Road
 - **C Rogers Road** between Brownes Road and R Seelingers Road
 - **Wynns Road** between C Rogers Road and High Eden Road
 - **High Eden Road** between Wynns Road and Springton Road
- Between 7.20am and 9.45pm on Saturday 29 August 2026**

SS2 & SS6 PLEASANT BOUNDARY 1 & 2

- **Carnells Boundary Road** between a point appx. 500m west of Torrens Valley Road and Cromer Road
 - **Cromer Road** between Carnells Boundary Road and H Muellers Road
 - **H Muellers Road** between Cromer Road and Whites Boundary Road
 - **Whites Boundary Road** between H Muellers Road and Cromer Road
 - **Blackwood Road** between Whites Boundary Road and Altmann Road
 - **Altmann Road** between Blackwood Road and a point appx. 200m south of Cricks Mill Road
- Between 8.50am and 6.00pm on Saturday 29 August 2026**

SS3 & SS5 GREEN & GOLD 1 & 2

- **Allendale Road** between a point appx. 1.5km southeast of Balmoral Road and Goldfields Road
 - **Woodlands Road** between Allendale Road and Goldfields Road
 - **Goldfields Road** between Woodlands Road and Green Gully Road
 - **Green Gully Road** between Goldfields Road and Para Wirra Road
 - **Para Wirra Road** between Green Gully Road and a point appx. 500m northwest of Humbug Scrub Road
- Between 9.00am and 5.30pm on Saturday 29 August 2026**

SS4 & SS7 McBEANS 1 & 2

- **Glen Devon Road** between McBean Road and McBeans Range Road
- **McBeans Range Road** between Glen Devon Road and a point appx. 1km south of Springton Road

Between 9.50am and 6.45pm on Saturday 29 August 2026

SS9 MOSSY PINE

- **Moss Smith Road** between a point appx. 2km north of Shearers Road and Rhine Park Road
- **Rhine Park Road** between Moss Smith Road and a point appx. 200m east of Eden Valley Road

Between 4.30pm and 10.15pm on Saturday 29 August 2026

SS10 CORNER STONE

- **Stone Jar Road** between Boundary Road and Hutton Vale Road
- **Hutton Vale Road** between Stone Jar Road and Lamb Tail Corner Road
- **Lamb Tail Corner Road** between Hutton Vale Road and Lindsay Park Road
- **Lindsay Park Road** between Lamb Tail Corner Road and a point appx. 200m south of Stott Highway

Between 5.00pm and 10.45pm on Saturday 29 August 2026

I direct that competitors and officials taking part in the '**2026 MSS Safety Rally Barossa**' be exempted, in relation to a road on which the event is to be held, from the duty to observe any enactment, regulation or by-law prescribing a rule to be observed on roads by drivers of vehicles.

The participants undertake the event wholly at their own risk and shall release and indemnify the Police Commissioner for any liability for injury or damage whatsoever inclusive of injury or loss sustained by third parties.

I further direct that the event must comply with the following:

- Comply with all Motor Sport Australia requirements
- All closures must be conducted by personnel with the appropriate Work Zone Traffic Management training and utilising approved signage
- All vehicles participating must be registered and road worthy
- All participants must hold appropriate drivers licence and not be disqualified from driving or from holding a licence in any State or Territory.
- Participants are not exempt from RTA offences related to drink and drug driving

I hereby authorise the **Rally SA**, its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of the speed zones.

I direct that the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event can only be performed by a person with work zone traffic management training.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the "**SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management**" (which calls up the **Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
