NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Christopher Drew Holland, Senior Sergeant First Class of Police, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that the **'2027 Valley Hot Rodders Cruise On'** is an event to which this section applies and that the following roads be closed to traffic **between 4.00pm and 11.00pm on Saturday 16 January 2027:**

Within The Barossa Council area: -

- **Murray Street, Tanunda** between Bridge Street and Theodor Street
- **Basedow Road, Tanunda** between Murray Street and MacDonnell Street

I direct that persons taking part in the **'2026 Valley Hot Rodders Cruise On'** on the above roads be exempted from all Australian Road Rules relating to pedestrian behaviour on roads.

I also hereby authorise **The Barossa Council** or its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event.

I direct that the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event can only be performed by a person with work zone traffic management training.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the **"SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management"** (which calls up the **Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
