NOTICE UNDER SECTION 33 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I, Christopher Drew Holland, Senior Sergeant First Class, for, and on behalf of the Commissioner of Police, exercise the authority delegated by the Minister for Transport under Section 11 Road Traffic Act, and make the following order under Section 33 of the Act.

I declare that **'2026 Barossa Marathon Festival'** is an event to which this section applies and that the following roads be closed to **between 5.00am and 1.00pm on Sunday 23 August 2026:**

Within The Barossa Council area: -

- **Magnolia Road, Tanunda** between Menge Road and Neldner Road
- **Research Road, Tanunda** between Magnolia Road and Angaston Road
- **Nuraip Road, Nuriootpa** between Research Road and Light Pass Road
- **Light Pass Road, Light Pass** between Nuraip Road and Penrice Road
- **Penrice Road, Light Pass** between Stockwell Road and Research Road
- **Research Road, Nuriootpa** between Penrice Road and Angaston Road

I direct that persons taking part in the **'2026 Barossa Marathon Festival'** on the above road be exempted from all Australian Road Rules relating to pedestrian behaviour on roads.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE NOTICE UNDER SECTION 17 (3) ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1961

I further declare that the **'2026 Barossa Marathon Festival'** to be conducted at **Tanunda and surrounds** is a **'temporary purpose'** to which this section applies.

I direct that a **25km/h temporary speed restriction** will apply to the following roads **between 5.00am and 1.00pm on Sunday 23 August 2026:**

Within The Barossa Council area: -

- **Magnolia Road, Tanunda** between Neldner Road and a point approximately 200m east
- **Neldner Road, Tanunda** between Magnolia Road and a point approximately 200m south
- **Angaston Road, Angaston** for 100 metres either side of Light Pass Road.

I also hereby authorise **ForMile Traffic Management** or its agents and contractors to install and remove, or cause the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event.

I direct that the installation and removal of necessary and appropriate traffic control devices for the conduct of this event can only be performed by a person with work zone traffic management training.

All works to be undertaken must be done so in accordance with the **"SA Standards for Workzone Traffic Management"** (which calls up the **Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management and AS1742.3**).

The permit holder must ensure that, a legible and complete copy of this Approval (as either a hard copy or electronic copy) is available at the event site at all times that workers are present and is immediately provided to an Authorised Officer upon request.
