MANAGEMENT PLAN 6 – CEMETERY LAND

This Community Land Management Plan identifies objectives, and performance targets and measures for the management of The Barossa Council's cemetery land for use by the community and visitors.

OBJECTIVES, POLICIES AND PROPOSALS FOR MANAGEMENT OF THE LAND

- < To provide a well maintained cemetery which can be visited by members of the community and has adequate reserve infrastructure to assist in the comfort of visitors.
- < The provision of burial rights for the deceased.

PERFORMANCE TARGETS

- < To facilitate in the granting of appropriate burial rights for the deceased.
- < To ensure all lawned and landscaped areas are maintained to a reasonable standard.
- < Adequate control of weeds, overgrowth and other hazards.
- < To ensure all fencing is safe and in reasonable condition.
- < To ensure any reserve infrastructure (ie bins and benches) and toilets provided are in a reasonable condition and are suitable for use by the community.

PERFORMANCE MEASURES

- < Regular maintenance and grounds work of lawned and/or garden areas as appropriate.
- < Periodic maintenance inspections of fencing, toilets and cemetery infrastructure to be undertaken.
