

Standpipe User Guide

Note: Users take water from the supply on the understanding that it may not be suitable for human consumption. Please refer to the Terms of Use which can be found on The Barossa Council's Website.

The Standpipes are 24/7 accessible and easy to operate in one complete transaction on your mobile phone. Your mobile phone will need to be able to read QR codes. You can either set up a PayPal account prior to your first use, or select 'Pay with a Card' to enter your credit card details for payment.

Step by Step

1. Scan the QR code

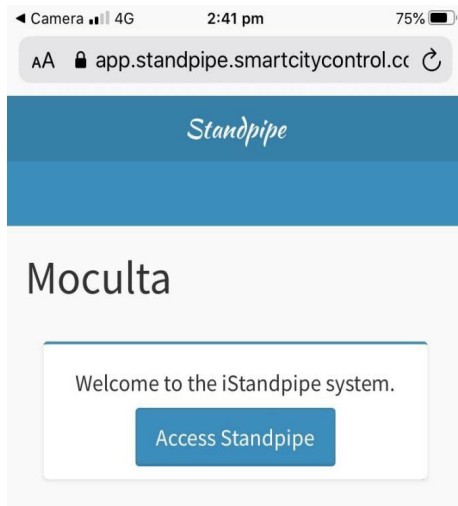
With your mobile, select camera and scan the QR code located on the right side of the control panel.

Casual users:

1. Scan the QR code
2. Click Access Standpipe
3. Log in with PayPal and add credit
4. You will only be charged for what you use
5. Press the green button, valve will open
6. Press the red button to close the valve



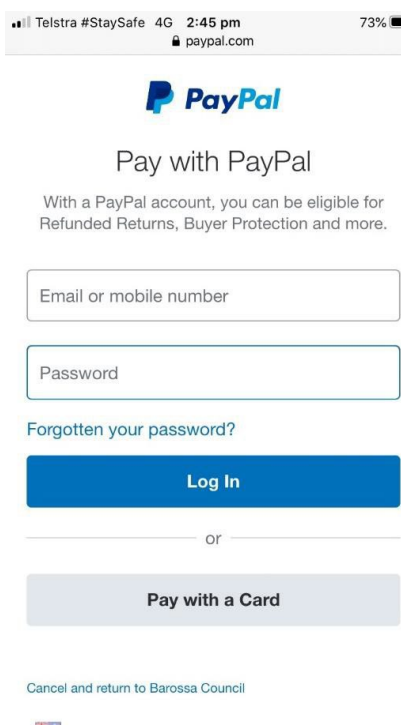
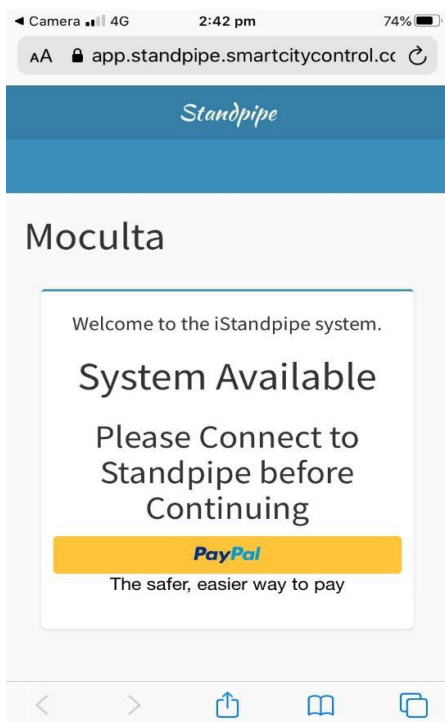
2. Click the 'Access Standpipe' button



3. Log in with PayPal

If you do not have a PayPal account, click the 'Pay with a Card' button to pay with your credit card.

*The automatic default is \$30.00. This is the maximum amount available for dispensing water in any one transaction. Only the **actual amount used** will be **deducted from your account**.*



4. Ensure secure connection

Ensure either of the following:

- Secure connection is made to the 50mm male cam lock, or,
- place the fill hose directly into your container.

5. Open the appropriate valve as per your discharge method



6. Press the green to start water flow

7. Press the red button to stop the water flow



8. Close the valve

Close the right valve as per your discharge method and disconnect the 50mm cam lock if used.

9. Complete

Please leave the standpipe area in good condition ready for the next user.
