David Babbage grew up in Greenock and attended Nuriootpa High School before beginning his working life with the National Bank in 1969.

After one year, David chose a different path and joined the Regular Army in July 1971, serving with distinction across a career that spanned more than four decades.

He rose through the ranks from Private to Warrant Officer Class One by 1986, and was commissioned as a Captain in 1993, David ultimately retired in 2013 as a Major.

David's service included active deployments to Iraq and Afghanistan, as well as humanitarian operations with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees in Bosnia, Rwanda, and Kosovo during the 1990s.
