

What are the affected areas and what properties and assets are in each affected area?

1. **Concordia Growth Area** includes 47 properties, approximately half of which are residential and half of which are primary production. It is largely rural. It is in the Barossa Council and council assets in the area are roads.
2. **Hewett** contains more than 1,000 properties, most of which are residential. It is in Light Regional Council and council infrastructure includes open space, bridges, footpaths and other paths, parking area, roads and traffic control, retaining walls and stormwater infrastructure. Community services and assets within Hewett include:
 - McKinlay Square Park
 - Gardens
 - Osprey Parade Reserve and Rosella Circuit playgrounds
 - Hewett Centre, a community and function centre
 - A shared path
 - Hewett Primary School and Stepping Stone Hewett Childcare Centre
3. **Kalbeeba (part)** contains 159 properties, most of which are residential. It is in The Barossa Council and council assets in the area are roads. Services in the area include the Concordia CFS, the Jack Bobridge walking and cycling track and the Kalbeeba Rail Station Platform.
4. **Gawler Belt (part)** consists of 360 properties, more than two-thirds of which are residential and others that are primary production. It is in Light Regional Council and council assets include footpaths, parking areas, roads, posts, signs and stormwater infrastructure. The area includes Xavier College, a number of small businesses and one commercial property.

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5. **Evanston Park (part)** is a suburb currently located in Town of Gawler and the City of Playford, with the portion in the City of Playford affected by the proposal. Council assets include roads and storm water management infrastructure. The affected area is largely rural residential properties.

6. **Reid (part)** is two residential properties currently in Light Regional Council, proposed to move to the Town of Gawler. Council assets are posts and roads.

7. **Hillier (part)** consists of 26 properties, most of which are rural residential and primary production. It is in the City of Playford and council assets are roads and kerbs, water pipes and signage. There is one commercial site and one Buddhist Temple.

8. **Bibaringa (part)** is five rural residential/primary production properties. It is in the Town of Gawler and proposed to move to the City of Playford. Council assets include roads and storm water management infrastructure.

9. **Uleybury (part)** is 25 properties, zoned rural residential and house and agriculture. Council assets include roads and storm water management infrastructure.
