Elected Member Workshop held on Wednesday 6 May 2026 at 5:30pm in the Council Chambers, 43-51 Tanunda Road, Nuriootpa.

1. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/PRESENTATIONS

1.1 Events Activation - Sporting Car Club of SA

Notes: The Sporting Car Club of SA presented to Council a Strategic Partnership Proposal and shared its objectives for the Collingrove Hill Climb site, including: re-positioning Collingrove as a greenfield venue capable of hosting local and international events, as well as its existing motorsport activity; re-development of Collingrove site including civil works, buildings and utilities; and launching a new brand identity, supported by consumer facing advertising campaigns – locally and internationally – with a view to attracting tourism.

1.2 Community Governance Framework, Seed Funding Model and Wellbeing & Inclusion Plan - Overview

Notes: An overview was provided of a proposed Community Governance Framework to be introduced consisting of a three-tier structure covering strategic leadership; action and delivery groups; and a coordination and learning alliance. A seed funding model was also proposed to replace the existing Community Assistance Scheme. A Wellbeing and Inclusion Plan approach was also presented, integrating the Disability Action and Inclusion Plan, Regional Public Health Plan and aligning with the Aboriginal Engagement Framework.

1.3 Budget - Valuations and Rating - Any Final Adjustments

Notes: An update was provided on revised budget settings since the April 2026 Workshop along with rating, service charges and valuation assumptions and a proposed 2026/27 model, along with alternative models, informing the development of the draft 2026/27 Operating and Capital budgets.

1.4 Draft Annual Business Plan and Budget, Long Term Financial Plan and Corporate Plan Documents for Review

Notes: A draft Annual Business Plan and Budget, Long Term Financial Plan and Corporate Plan were presented for Council review noting that final published versions would be developed for consideration and adoption at the Special Council Meeting proposed for 13 May 2026.
